APRIL 16 – MAY 11 TERM: Both diploma and 4th-year students will be on campus. Please pray that faculty will seek God's guidance as we add new 1st-year students. I, John, will teach "Hermeneutics" (1st-yrs), "Advanced Preaching" (4th-yrs), and co-teach "New Testament Greek 1" (4th-yrs) with Paget Kintu. This term will also be the first time the course "Ministering to Children" will be taught. GO missionary Stephen Napier will teach this as an adjunct professor. We are anxious to begin hearing results of more children coming to Christ.

GTS FINANCES: Please make GTS funding a matter of prayer. The sugar cane income helps us, but we will not harvest any again until June/July. GTS scholarships keep the school term going, but funding for current expenses are coming mainly from our family's pocket. We are making adjustments and GTS is delaying some key farm work.
